The first church designed by renowned mid-century modern architect Alden B. Dow, Christ Covenant has taken great care of their beautiful building. A few years ago, they explored sealing and striping options for their parking lot but were advised by contractors to pursue a full resurfacing. The project will cost upwards of \$80,000-\$115,000. The Presbytery's goal of raising \$50,000 through the Spring Offering will help to relieve much of the financial burden of this cost. 
